2Peter 3:5-10 The Final Cataclysm of the Day of the Lord: Peter's Twofold Answer to the Cynical Mockers

In verses 1-4, we are reminded that in the end times, the biblical promise of the 2^{nd} Advent with its attendant cataclysmic judgments will be ridiculed because of the apparent unbroken continuity of uniform processes in earth history. This apparent lack of Divine intervention in modern history bolsters the cynics' appraisal of the future: They ignore God's interventions in the past and see no reason He will intervene in the future. Hence, they dismiss the prophesied events of the 2^{nd} Advent as religious nonsense.

Peter's answer is twofold:

- 1) First: GOD DID INTERVENE CATACLYSMICALLY in the PAST, v.5-7; and
- 2) Second: GOD WILL AGAIN INTERVENE in the FUTURE, v. 7b-10.

v 7a Current Cosmology (since Gen. 8,9) & Future Judgment

NOTE THE EMPHASIS IN V.7:

Lit. *"but the <u>NOW</u> heavens and earth..."* = THE _____ COSMOLOGY

"BY THE SAME WORD..." = "BY WORD..."

"ARE HAVING BEEN RESERVED FOR FIRE..."* (*a Perfect Passive Periphrastic verbal)

"being kept unto a day of judgment and destruction of <u>the</u> ungodly men."

THE TWO-FOLD EMPHASIS:

- 1) God did intervene in the past, and
- 2) He will again in the future. Moreover, His intervention via the Noahic catastrophe, THE GREAT FLOOD, is the _____ between:
 - a. the heavens and earth of old (the original cosmic order), and
 - b. the post-flood heavens and earth (current cosmological & atmospheric conditions). Uniform processes as we know them apparently date from the Flood (cmp. Gen. 8:22).
