## John 17, The Lord's Prayer

The words recorded here were spoken somewhere between the upper room discourse (John 14-16) and Gethsemane, maybe near the Brook Kidron outside the eastern gate to the city of Jerusalem. In preparation for our study of this unique prayer, note the following 5 points:

1.	Although Jesus prayed often, this is His recorded prayer.			
2.	2. His prayer is addressed to His Father, holy & righteous, vrs. 1, 5, 11, 21, 24, 25.			
3.	This prayer contains (erotao, vrs. 9, 15, 20) & (note the imperative modes, vrs. 1, 5, 11, 17).
